## **CHURCH CAMP 2020**

Church camp was held on the 21 to 23 February and was a great time of teaching, relaxation, making new friends and catching up with old friends. 81 people attended this year and it was wonderful to have some first-time campers experiencing camp - Mardon Rd style.

We were blessed and encouraged by Jeff Deuble's teaching on Living a Life of Love based on the text in Mark 12:28-34 where the scribe asked Jesus which is the first of all commandments. Jesus answered with the well-known words: "The first of all the commandments is: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first commandment. And the second, like it, is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these." During the first session Jeff looked at the reasons for God's commandments: they are for our sake, not His; not as an imposition but as an invitation; not to restrict our freedom but to release Makayla, Dawson and Mo from us into true freedom; not to deprive us but to bless us; and, not as demands but as desires. The second session was about loving and trusting God: putting God first in our affections (heart); obeying when we don't feel like it (soul/will); following when it doesn't

make sense (mind); believing God will provide what we need when we need it (strength). On Sunday Jeff shared what God's love is: a love in action; selfless; principled and transcendent. The challenge is for us to show that love to each other.

As always, Saturday evening was a highlight with plenty of musical items and some side-splitting skits! Thank you everyone for coming and making it a special weekend! Next year's camp is booked on the 19 to 21 February.
