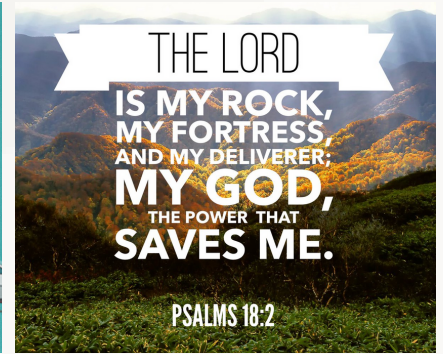
This is an event organised by Tearfund and every dollar raised will help people in poverty in Sri Lanka.
