Greetings once again to our Kiwi church family:

You find in Ecclesiastes there is a time for everything under the Sun. That seems to include COVID. We have now been dealing with this virus for two years and it's getting old to say the least.

I hope this note finds all of you well. We are good and continue to keep our guard up and practice social distancing. As I'm sure you are aware of, Omicron has hit hard. Right now we are averaging nearly 750,000 cases a day, record highs. We know some folks who have had COVID twice. Others who have been fully vaccinated have had the Delta as well as Omicron. Vaccination doesn't seem to stop the Omicron variant but it is less severe. The hospitalizations are fewer and the death count much less. That we thank the Lord for. We are still praying and trusting this variant will dissipate as quickly as it had arrived. Perhaps by February it will begin to slip away. I check on the New Zealand news and found Omicron is just getting started. When it does, it will run its course. Hopefully in two to three months you too will have it behind you.

We are sitting by waiting to see when your country will be opened back up for tourists.

Not sure how long the process is to gain a Visa, but we are still trusting the timing will all work for us to arrive in September. Praying for your ministry in the weeks and months ahead as you navigate your way through what we all hope will be the last variant at least for some time to come.

May God continue to pour out His blessings upon you.
