A LITTLE BIT OF HISTORY

it is 140 years since the Church of Christ (Life and Advent), now Mardon Road Church, commenced a ministry in Hamilton. In September 1882 two young men arrived in Hamilton from the Auckland church and, after making enquires on the availability of a hall, held a special meeting in LeQuesne's Hall in Hamilton East. Their aim was to spread the gospel of the grace of God, life only in Christ and his second coming. The church in the photo was erected in Claudelands, Hamilton, in **one week** from the 22nd to 29th October in 1911. Throughout the intervening years, until it's official closing on the 21st December 1969, this church sustained the work and witness in Hamilton and the surrounding areas.
